I am writing to inform you that work on the Chapel Farm Battery Energy Storage System is due to commence on Monday 25th July 2022. Details of the development can be found via the Central Bedfordshire Council planning portal, application number CB/21/04143/VOC.

The site is being developed on behalf of Harmony CF Limited and general details including the FAQs on battery energy storage can be found by visiting <https://www.harmonyenergy.co.uk/battery-energy-storage>.

Construction activities are expected to last eight months, completing in March 2023. Access to the site will be via the access road off the B579 Luton Road, and construction traffic will be directed via junction 11A of the M1, to avoid any increase in traffic within the village of Chalton. The highway adjacent to the site will be maintained and cleaned as required.

Normal working hours will be within the period 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and 8.00am to 1.00pm on Saturdays, if required.

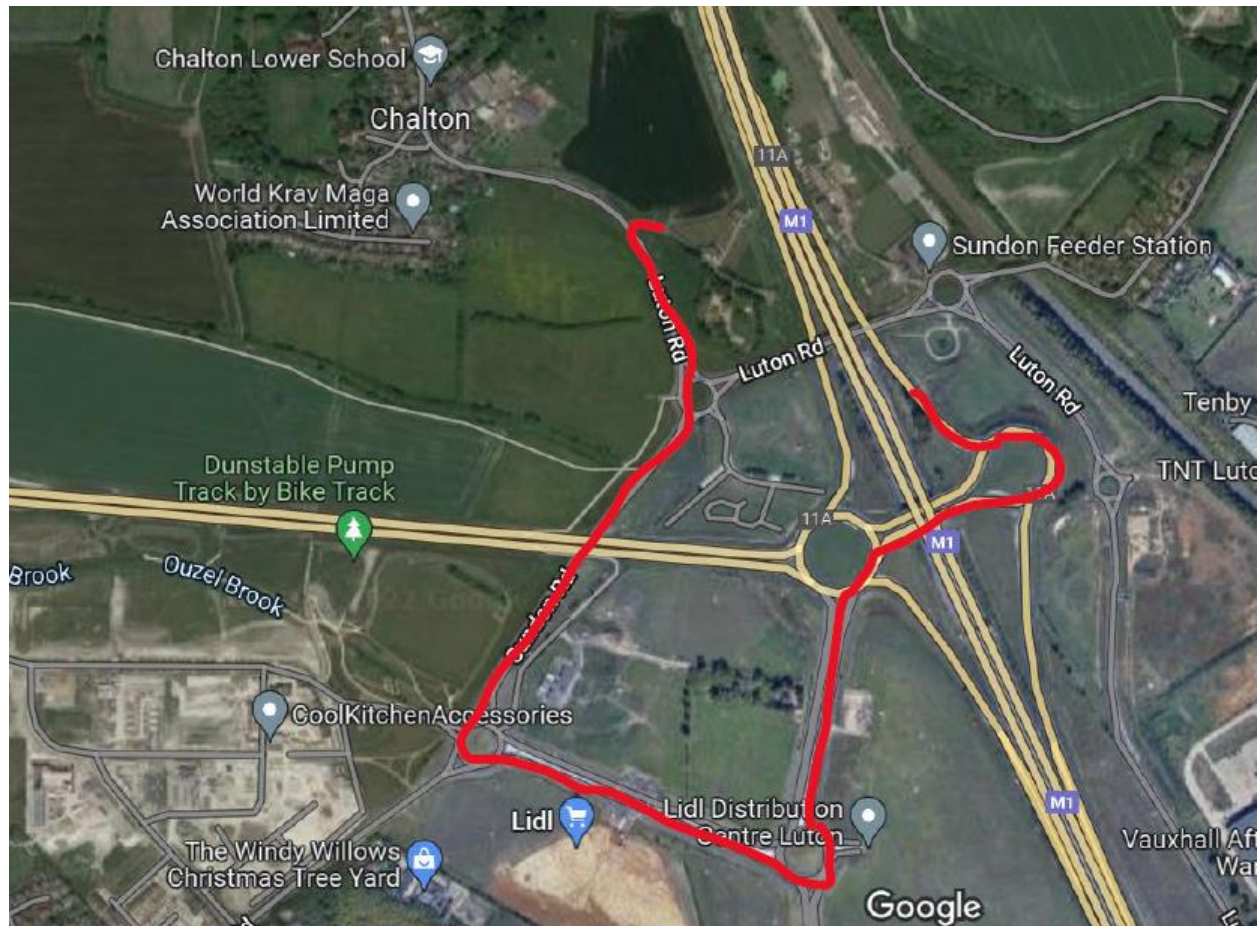
